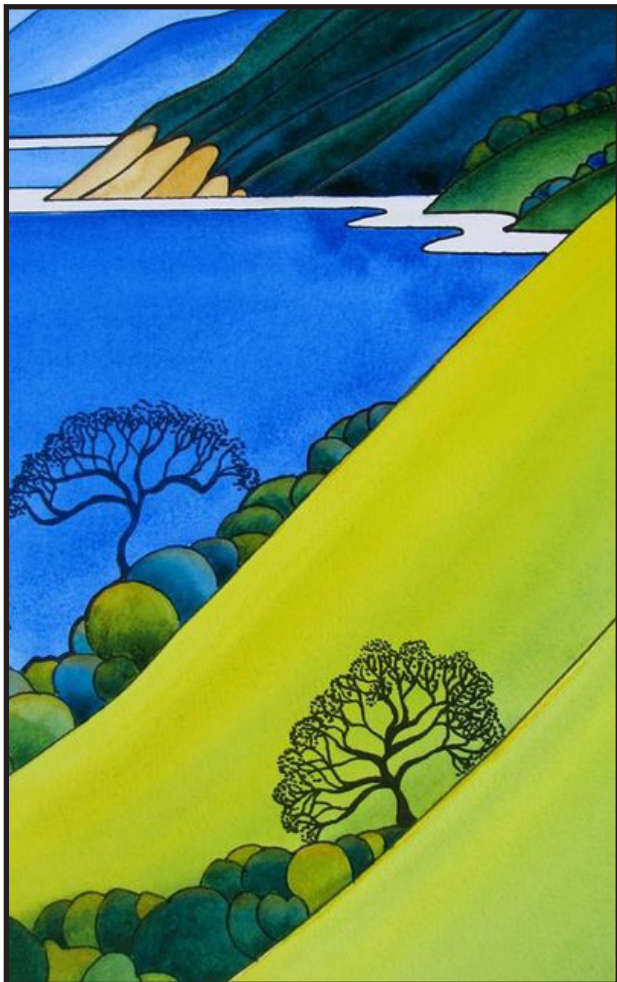




A SUMMER ARTS CAMP

CAMP I (7-12 YRS) JUNE 17-21 \$160

Students will focus on New Zealand as they explore traditional, modern, and contemporary arts and culture. This camp will touch upon mixed media landscapes, sculpture, printmaking, and collaborative work!

CAMP II (13-18 YRS) JULY 15-19 \$180

They will have opportunities in painting, sculpture, mixed media, collage, drawing, and textiles.

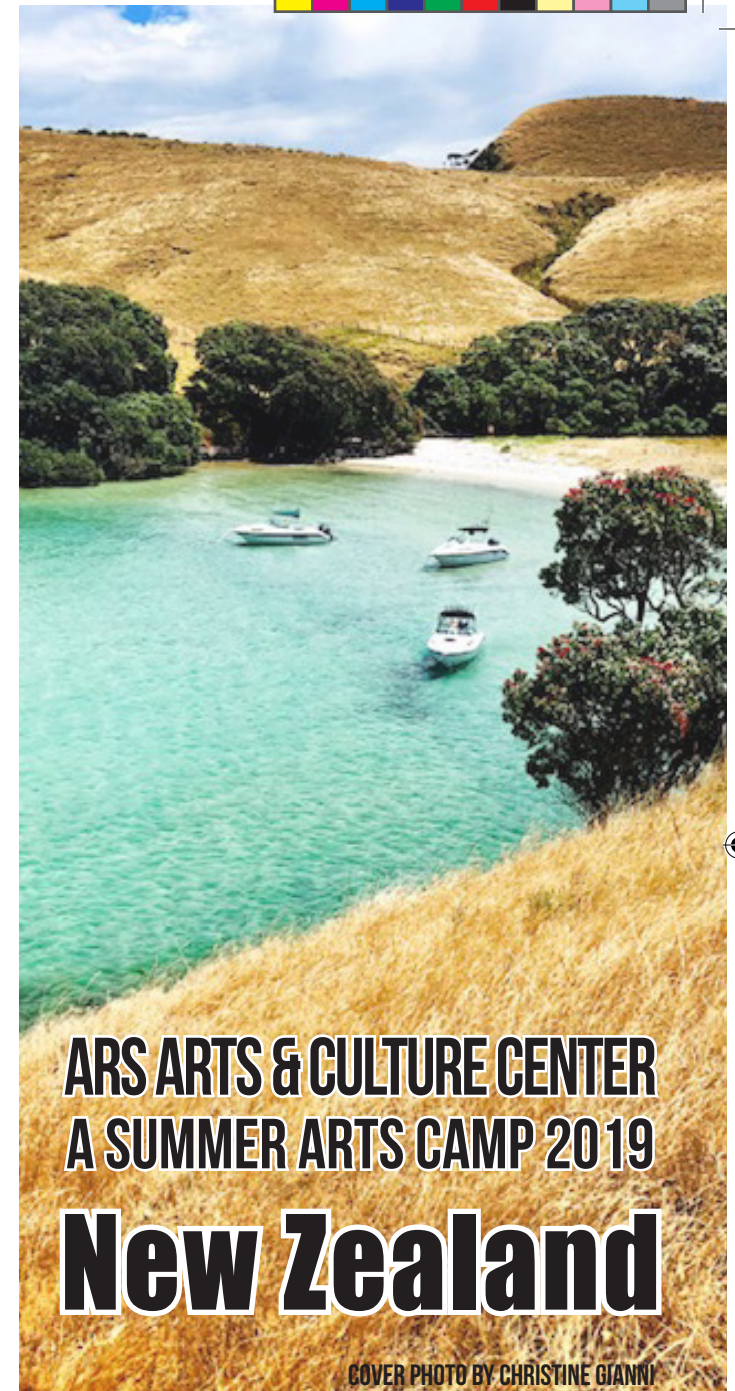
